# CHESAPEAKE TRAIL RIDING CLUB 25 MILE COMPETITIVE TRAIL RIDE. AND 12-MILE CDR (Conditioning Distance Ride)

**LOCATION:** Beautiful Fair Hill DNR, Maryland, upper barn area

**DATE:** Saturday, April 3, 2010

**TIME:** Judging for the 25 will happen both Friday afternoon at 5 pm and Saturday am. Saturday judging starts at 7am. The ride starts as soon as judging is complete. 12 Mile Ride judging begins at 7 am. The Ride starts as soon as judging is complete.

**ENTRY:** 12 Mile CDR \$40.00 per entry, Jrs \$25.00  
25 Mile CTR \$65.00 per entry, Jrs \$40.00

Entry must be confirmed not later than March 26, 2010. Ride entry is limited to 50 horses and riders. No refunds for cancellations after March 30th. Stalls and bedding (every distance) for Friday night is \$38.00 per night and arrangements must be made through ride management prior to March 27th. A separate deposit check for \$25.00 must accompany stall reservations. This check will be destroyed when your stall is cleaned and your ride evaluation turned in. Camping pads are \$35.00 and must be reserved through ride management by March 27th.

**DETAILS:** The 12/25 Mile rides are ECTRA (Eastern Competitive Trail Riding Association) sanctioned and will be conducted according to all rules and regulations set out by ECTRA. Helmets are required when mounted.

**AWARDS:** 12 Mile Rides will receive participation awards.  
25 Mile riders will receive awards for completing and placement awards.

**FOOD:** Donuts and coffee Saturday am, and lunch Saturday afternoon for all competitors. On-trail snacks and beverages will be provided.

**ELIGIBILITY:** For both distances, according to ECTRA guidelines, open to all equines 4 years (48 months) and older. Current negative coggins must accompany your ride entry or be provided at check-in.

**JUDGING:** In accordance with rules and regulations of ECTRA. It is the responsibility of all riders to know these rules. Rulebooks are available from Marilyn Miles, PO Box 76, Clarksville, NY 12041. Judges are Nick Kohut (Vet), Helen Stacy (Lay)

**FARRIER:** Hopefully, will be available at rider's expense. Any type shoes or Easyboots may be used; pads are optional. SHOES ARE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

**DISQUALIFICATION:** Will occur if any rider is found riding anywhere other than the marked trail; for use of any drugs before, during or after the ride prior to final judging; at the discretion of management or judges should a situation warrant. See ECTRA handbook pertaining to disqualification. **Any horse requiring treatment of any kind, or any horse that the judges deem necessary to treat and the rider/owner refuses treatment will be disqualified.** Management retains the right to drug test each day.

**TIME:** Ride time Saturday for 25 miles is 4:10 to 4:40. Riders more than 30 minutes early or late will be disqualified. Ride time for the 12 mile ride is TBD.

**TRAIL:** Will be marked with surveyor's tape, arrows and signs. Mileage markers will appear every 5 miles and each mile for the final 5 miles. Holds are in camp and **Canopies are**

**recommended as there is no shade in this area. The trail covers 12 or 25 miles of beautiful rolling hunt country in Fair Hill DNR.**

**TRAIL CONDUCT:** Riders should ask to pass only if safe to do so, and should avoid passing at a canter or a gallop. Red ribbons in tails of kickers; yellow ribbons in tails of stallions.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** No pleasure riding on trails during the ride except for drag riders. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Rider should provide own buckets, hay nets, feed and hay and grooming items. No leg protection or bandages. No internal or external medications allowed; note that Vicks, Swat cream and Vaseline fall into this category. Fly repellents, electrolytes, grooming products and water at ordinary temperatures may be used. *NO HOSING OF HORSES ALLOWED.* ASTM/SEI approved hard hats are mandatory and must be used whenever mounted. *NO BAREBACK RIDING.*

**REFUNDS:** Cancellations on or before March 26, 2010, only the \$25.00 deposit will NOT be refunded. Cancellations after March 26, 2010, no refunds. If entries warrant, a waiting list will be maintained; refunds are contingent on your place being filled from the waiting list. Refunds will be mailed after the ride.
